The Ifor Williams, Mobile Clinical Unit, is an innovative solution which has been designed to increase clinical capacity, whilst prioritising the safety of patients and staff and allowing for flexible use in a variety of healthcare contexts.

The Mobile Clinical Unit provides a number of solutions, not only as a safe and separate area for Covid-19 patient assessments, but also for wider clinical practice and other applications:

Covid-19 Applications

- Providing safe and separate facilities, to keep symptomatic patients away from non-symptomatic patients.
- Covid-19 Vaccination Unit.

Routine Clinical Applications

- Increasing clinical capacity for routine clinical assessments.
- Vaccination unit to support routine vaccinations for children in school or for routine winter vaccinations in the community.
- Mobile Clinical Unit for rural communities for GP assessments or for hospital specialty out-reach services.

Other Applications

- Occupational health assessments on-site for companies and businesses also faced with the need to separate and assess staff, rapidly.
- Mobile Clinical Unit for First Aid at large events.
- A Mobile Clinical Unit for Contractors working remotely and in need of additional Welfare Units to look after staff appropriately.

Separate Entry Points for Staff and Patients

To minimise direct contact between staff and patients.



Minimal Surfaces

To help with ease and speed of cleaning in between patient use.



Windows with Privacy Screens

A window within the consultation room allows for important ventilation with screens to ensure patient privacy.



Heater - 230V

Installed to provide comfort and a safe working environment during the colder winter months.



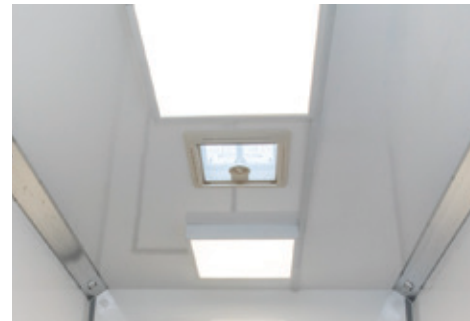
Large Consultation Room

To ensure that 2m social distancing can be maintained, when direct contact with the patient is not required.



Separate Antechamber

With worktop, fixed storage, and deployable plastic storage containers. Linking the staff entrance point to the main consultation room, this space allows the member of clinical staff to safely prepare for the consultation and put on the necessary PPE.



Bright LED Lights

12V wall lights, 230V ceiling lights and rooflights providing natural light and ventilation. This provides a professional setting to allow clinical staff to conduct a thorough and rigorous examination.



12V Battery

With 230V charger. Provides power to light the unit, when mains electricity is not available.

KEY FEATURES



Access Steps

The fold up access steps make the Mobile Clinical Unit easy to enter and exit. For patient access a large double step will also be provided with a handrail.



Rear Propstand / Front Corner Steadies

Wind down corner steadies at the front and drop down propstands at the rear to stabilise the unit.



Mains Electricity Hook Up

Provides a continuous power supply, where mains electricity can be accessed.



Vinyl Flooring

Both durable and easy to clean, vinyl flooring is ideal for clinical use.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS



Tie Rings

Can be used to secure any equipment while you are on the move.



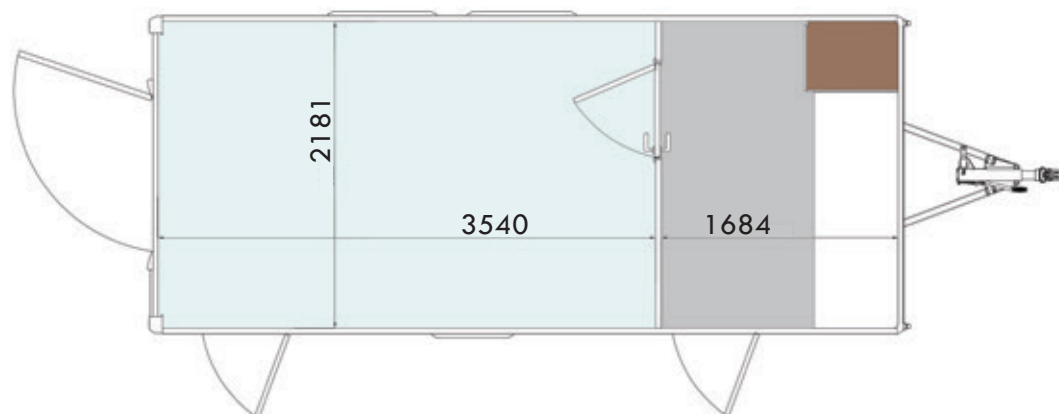
Solar Panel

The solar panel is positioned on the roof of the unit and re-charges the battery during daylight hours.

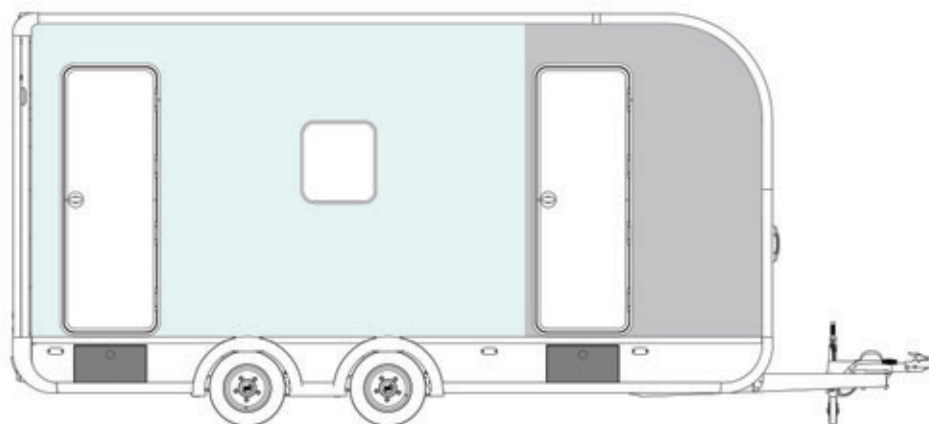

TRAILER WRAPPING

Vinyl graphics can be used to add a logo, or for maximum impact, the whole trailer can be covered in a detailed wrap, giving your Mobile Clinical Unit visual appeal, branding, or even visual instructions for patients.

The vinyl wrap is of very good quality and acts as a protective barrier to your trailer. It protects paintwork and panels from stone chips and minor abrasions. The wrap will last many years because of the anti-UV fade technology. It can easily be removed should you wish to update the graphics or return the trailer to its original state and colour. The trailer can be washed by hand or jet washed but we advise against the use of mechanical car washes as the abrasive action could damage the wrap.
